About the event

Limerick is a kind of humorous verse of five lines, in which the first, second and fifth lines rhyme with each other and the third and fourth lines, which are shorter, form a rhymed couplet. A limerick is always written in 'aabba' rhyming scheme. It also contains an illustration to present the essence of the limerick.

Objective of the Event

- To create a limerick using rhyme schemes and illustrations.
- To enable the students to explore their imagination and showcase their creative side.
- To enable the students to use the given rhyming words in an appropriate manner.
- To enhance and check language, vocabulary, overall structure, relevance and use of rhyme.

The Event and Participation

Limerick activity was conducted on 3 August in all the sections of std. III. The activity involves writing five humorous lines. The activity enabled the students to use their imagination and showcase their creative side with proper use of vocabulary and enhance their writing skills. The students were provided with a paper and a set of rhyming words. They were asked to write a limerick in 30 minutes and were given 2 minutes each for presentation. Students were allowed to use dictionaries for reference. Best 5 limericks of each class were selected and displayed on their respective soft boards. All the students participated with great enthusiasm.
