Pronouns that replace the names of persons or things are called personal pronouns.

I like to draw. Rohan gave a drawing book to me.

We are playing. Come, join us.

The pronouns I, me, we and us refer to the speaker.

I and *me* are singular pronouns. They refer to one speaker.

We and us are plural pronouns. They refer to more than one speaker.

The pronoun you refers to the listener. It may be singular or plural.

Radhika, you may go out and play. (singular)

All of you must come tomorrow. (plural)

The pronouns *he*, *she*, *it*, *him*, *her*, *they* and *them* replace the person(s) or thing(s) the speaker is speaking about.

He slept after the doctor gave him the tablet.

She taught them how to sing.

They gave her a card.

Soma bought a cake. It was delicious.


