Delhi Public School Gandhinagar successfully organised a vaccination drive for children born in the age group of 15-18 years on 7th January 2022. This drive was conducted under the guidelines and safety protocols from the GMC office Gujarat. Dr.Dhaval Patel, Municipal Commissioner, Gandhinagar shared a short video urging the parents and children to participate in this vaccination drive and take the first step towards protection against Covid-19. Over 500 vaccines were successfully administered during this drive.

The parents and children of Class 9 to 12 were duly informed by the school along with step by step instructions. Separate time slots were provided to avoid gathering of people and to ensure social distancing. The eligibility of children included all those who were born on or before 31st December 2007. The vaccination administered was COVAXIN vaccine. The parents had to register themselves in the COWIN app. However, online registration by the Health officials was also conducted in the school premises.

The children who arrived with their parents were sent for onsite registration, where a team cross-verified the health condition viz. 1. Checking of body temperature 2. Whether breakfast was consumed or not 3. Any other ailments like cold, cough etc.

After the registration, the children were kept under a 10 minute observation under the guidance of the school counsellor for any signs of anxiety and apprehension. After administering the vaccine, the children were kept under another 30 minute observation before dispersal.

For the smooth flow of the vaccination drive, various rooms were arranged like- Parent waiting room, Vaccination Administering Room, Post Vaccination observation room etc.

Overall the drive was a huge success with utmost cooperation from the Parents, Children, GMC Health Officials, School Management, Teachers and other Staff members.

The entire team of DPS Gandhinagar extends its heartfelt gratitude to all those who participated in this drive and performed their role effectively.
