About the Event

The Primary Wing of Delhi Public School Gandhinagar organized an awareness programme on disaster management by the team of National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) Gandhinagar for the students of Std. IV and V. The NDRF is a specialized force constituted for the purpose of specialist response in the event of a disaster.

Objective of the Event

- To help students learn about natural calamities and steps to be taken in such critical situations
- To help students learn about basic survival and first aid skills.
- To create awareness and the role played by agencies such as NDRF.

The Event and participation

The session started with a brief introduction of NDRF and its activities. The session included a slide show of photographs and videos of work executed by NDRF teams in the past such as the recent floods in Kerala, floods in Banaskantha last year as well as the support extended during the Nepal earthquake. The State of Gujarat is susceptible to earthquake, cyclone and floods. In order to demonstrate their readiness in such crisis the NDRF personnel showcased some of the equipments, tools and machineries which are used by them. The main motto of NDRF is to save human life. They do so using manual methods as well as technical gadgets and equipments such as various cutters and drills. They also take the help of dog squads. The NDRF team also imparted various tips on First aid to the students and demonstrated how to impart first aid and how to make stretchers from house hold items and also help save people from drowning by using basic things found at home. The students keenly watched and learnt all the techniques. They were truly inspired and motivated to know about such a selfless dedicated, fearless, adventurous team of real life heroes. The event concluded with a vote of thanks and a small token of gratitude by Headmaster of Primary Wing.
