About the Event

The Primary Wing of Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar organised English Calligraphy competition for students of Std. 3 to 5 on 13 July 2018. Calligraphy is the art of beautiful handwriting. The term is derived from Greek words 'kallos' (beauty) and 'graphein' (to write). The competition focussed on bringing out creative skills of students so that they could write letters in an aesthetically pleasing manner.

- To develop artistic skills and love for writing along with increase in levels of concentration and patience.

The screening for the same was undertaken by respective class teachers which were then forwarded to the class representatives. The best three students from each standard were selected by the teachers of the English Department
