The main attraction of the assembly today was the PEP Talk on Cyber-Safety. A panel of four students Shrey Patel, Maduksha Gupta, Mehvish Ahmedi, Sakshi Purohit of class XI- C presented an informative and explanatory discussion on cyber safety and cyber bullying in a very interesting way. This panel of PEP Presenters discussed almost every aspect like Role of Parents in monitoring, Parental Locks for some sites, having proper Anti-Virus and security settings and many more tips on cyber safety. Students were encouraged to report any negative issues they may encounter online to a trusted adult. They were made aware of the relevant legislation when using the internet such as data protection and intellectual property which may limit what they want to do but also serves to protect them.
