Pi Approximation Day is observed every year on July 22 all around the globe. The fraction $22/7$ is an approximate value of Pi, and there behind lies a particular reason why this day is observed on July 22. It has been represented by a Greek letter since the mid-18th century. Being an irrational number, Pi cannot be expressed precisely as a ratio of any two integers. Thus, its decimal representation never closes and never settles into a permanent repeating pattern.
