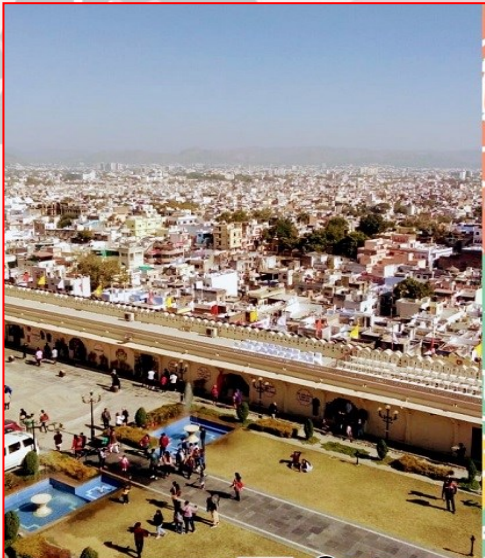
# Educational Tour

## TRIP TO UDAIPUR

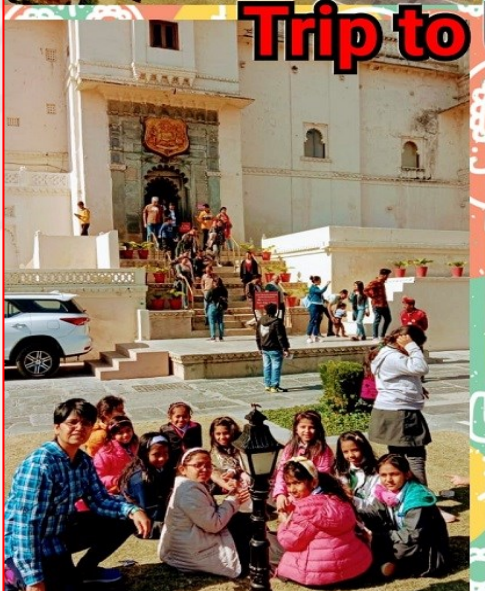

The staff members enjoyed to the fullest. The early chilly winter morning brought lots of enthusiasm and rejuvenated the staff members to face the routine work.

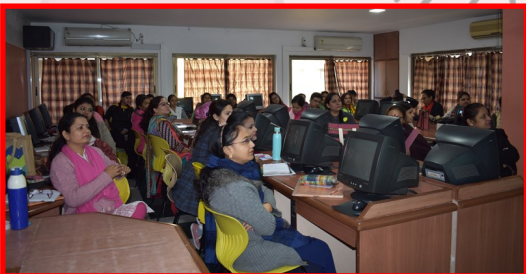




# Teacher's Corner
