Basant Panchami, is a festival that marks the preliminary preparations for the arrival of spring, celebrated by people in various ways depending upon the region in the Indian subcontinent. To teach children about this festival, Delhi Public School Gandhinagar arranged virtual celebration on the day of Basant Panchami, 16th February. Children celebrated the festival with lots of fun and zeal. The festival of Basant Panchami is associated with yellow colour, a colour of spirituality, so children were asked to wear yellow clothes to symbolize the significance of the colour, in the festival. The celebration started with Saraswati Vandana and followed by ppt, live pooja and art and craft activity. They were asked to offer prayer to Goddess Saraswati, seek her blessings by placing the stationary items like pen, pencils and notebooks at her feet, they offered yellow flowers and yellow sweet as prasad. Children made book mark and pencil stand with yellow theme using small cut outs of veena, lotus flower, books and Goddess Saraswati. Children were explained about the significance of the act of donation on this day and were encouraged to distribute stationery items like pen, pencils and notebooks among needy children with the help of their parents. Celebrating Basant Panchami helped them to understand the significance of changes that occur in different seasons, to accept and welcome the changes in their life, with enthusiasm and confidence.
