National Science Day of India is celebrated to mark the discovery of Raman Effect by Sir Chandrasekhara Venkataraman who won the Nobel Prize for this discovery in 1930. To mark the importance of the event, **Institute for Plasma Research (IPR)**, Gandhinagar organized an Inter School event covering various topics ranging from Science models to Essay writing and Poster making for classes from 9-12.

Our team from DPS Gandhinagar comprising two students, **Sommyartha Biyani** and **Ishita Gupta** of Class IX participated in the category of Science Model Making event. Students prepared an OS-SD [Optically Sensed Sanitizer Dispenser]. In the first round, students were required to upload video clips of demonstration of their model on YouTube explaining it in detail by 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.

Team DPS Gandhinagar was selected in the first round and the final round for the same was conducted on Google Meet by the IPR on February 8, 2021. There were six members in the selection team. They appreciated the efforts of the students and motivated them for taking up more such initiatives. The results were announced on the same day where DPS Gandhinagar bagged the **second** position.
