




CORONART CHALLENGE

The objective of this activity was to learn and implement safety and protection measures, through art.

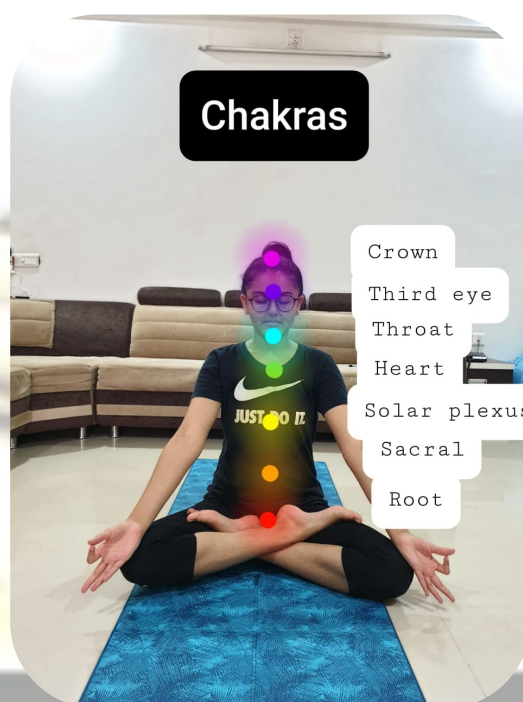

YOGA DAY

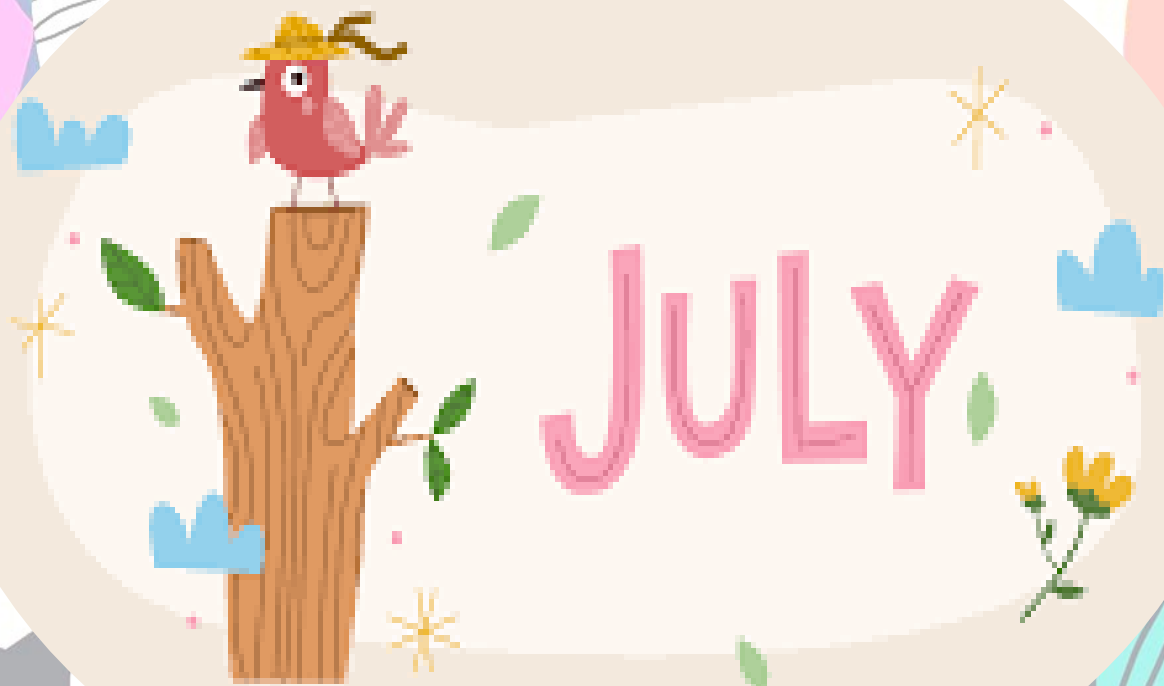

The main purpose of this activity was to understand and implement coordination and synchronisation of mind, body and soul for a healthy and balanced life.





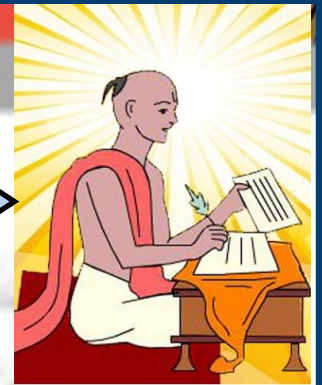
CCA for the Month of July 2020

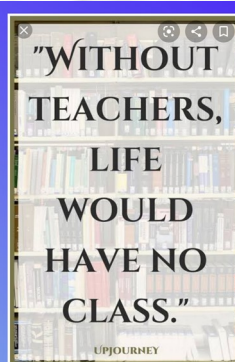

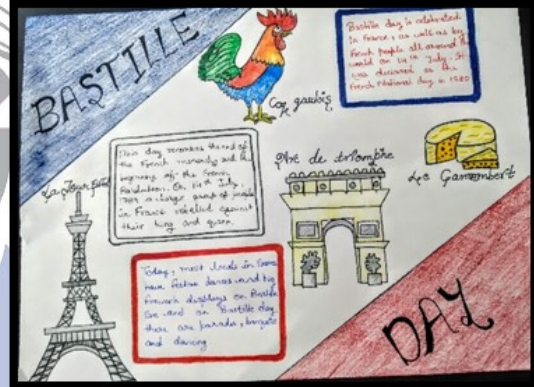


FRENCH DAY

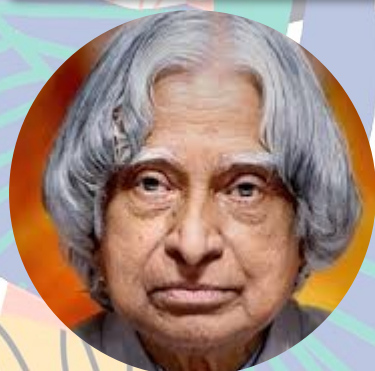

Dance helps students to express emotions, and understand the 'forms and techniques' of dancing through recreation.

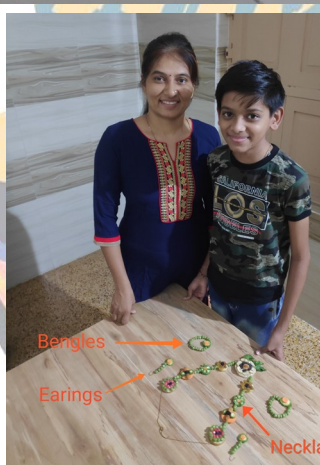


VEGGIE JEWELLERY

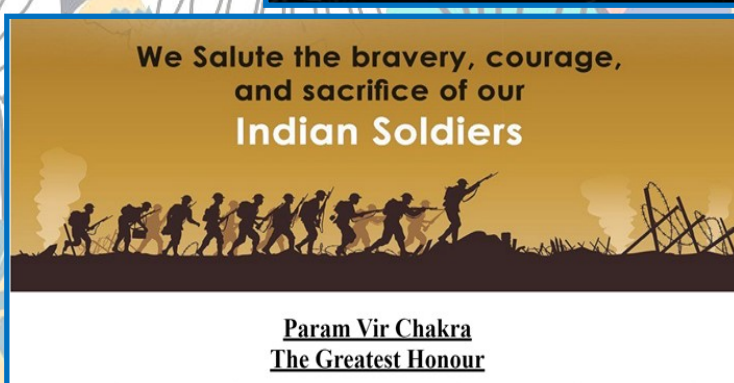
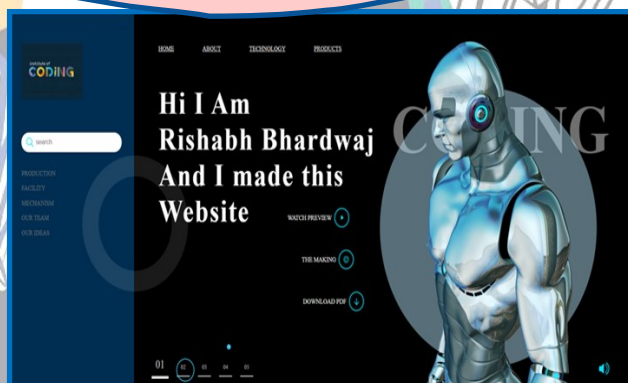
TWIST YOUR BRAIN

I. Information

- COVID-19 is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus.
- Most people infected with the COVID-19 virus will experience mild to moderate respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment. The Cold Desert: LADAKH

The stark and pristine landscape of Ladakh, bound by rugged mountains, deep gorges and harsh terrain is ideal for adventure sports like trekking, mountain climbing, camping, etc. Moreover, the gurgling Indus and Zaskar rivers cutting through the scenery provide perfect backdrops for adventure in the winter.

Places to visit in Ladakh

PANGONG LAKE:
At an altitude of 4350m and a five hour drive away from Leh, the Pangong Lake is an endorheic (undrained) lake. The prime attraction of Ladakh, it changes colours from azure to light blue to green and grey. It became a tourist hot-spot owing to the Bollywood movie "3 Idiots" that was shot here.

ZASKAR VALLEY:
Located in the Kargil district to the east of Ladakh (around 305 km) lies the bewitching Zaskar Valley. The semi-desert region is flanked by snow-capped mountains and sparkling clear rivers along with distinct flora and fauna. The easiest way of reaching Zaskar is from Kargil through Suru Valley.

KHARDUNG LA:
Khardung La, also known as Kharidung La, is a high mountain pass in Ladakh region of Jammu and Kashmir, near Leh. It serves as the gateway to Shigok and Nubra Valley. Khardung La is popular as the highest motor able road in India at an elevation of 5602 metres.

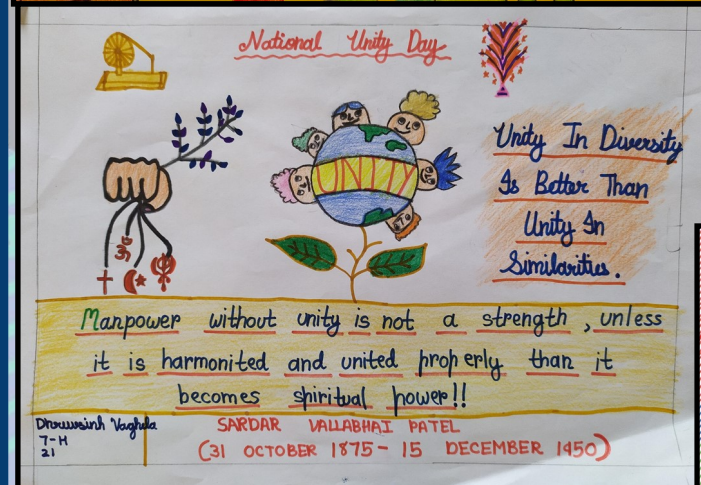
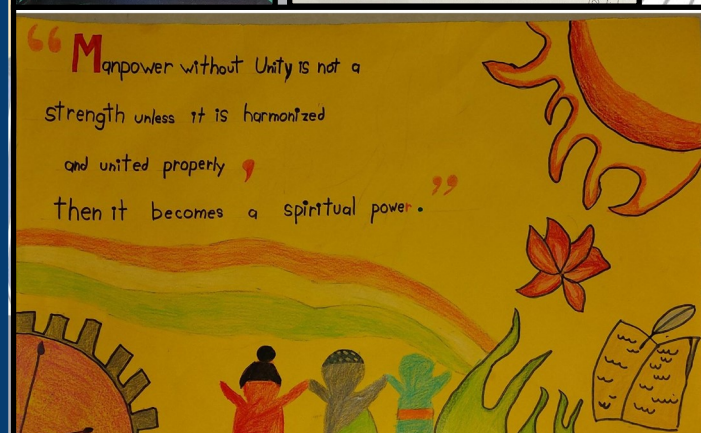
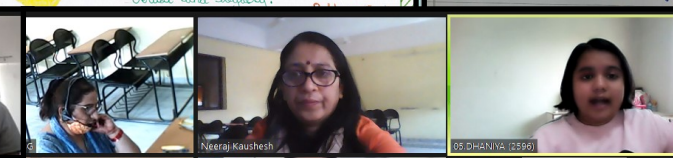
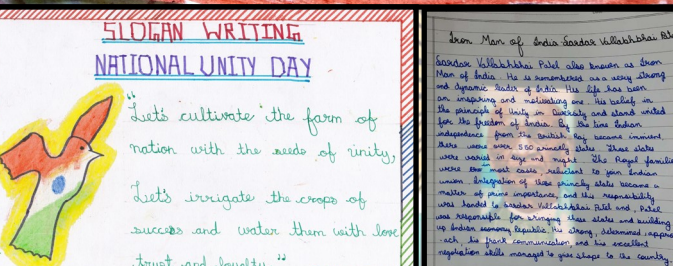
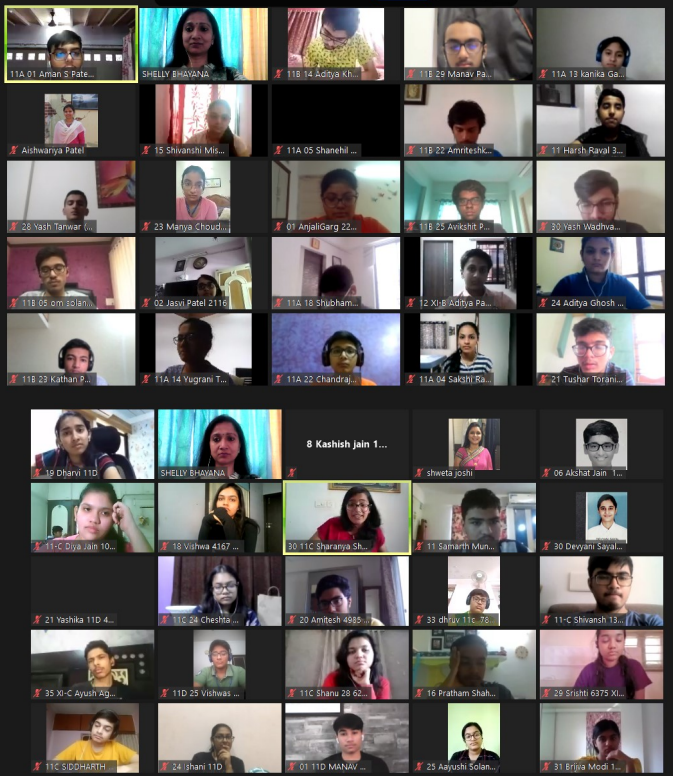

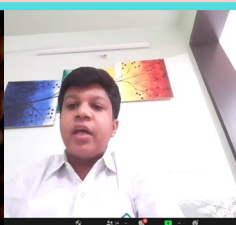
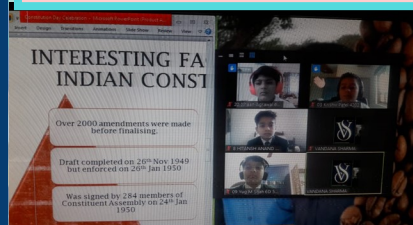
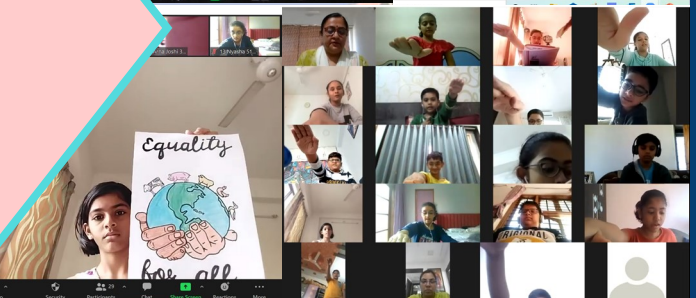
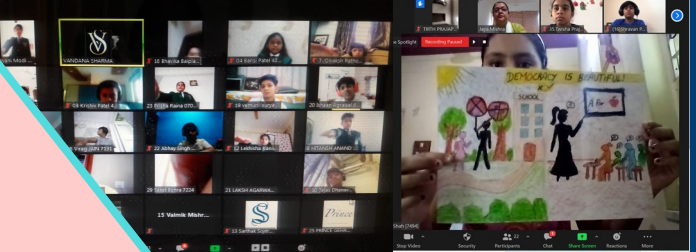
The main objective of this activity was to help students learn about endangered species and our need to protect them and restore the balance of nature.

National Mathematics Day

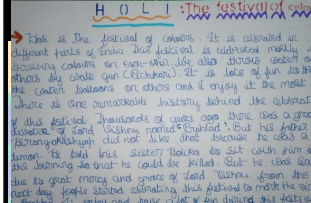
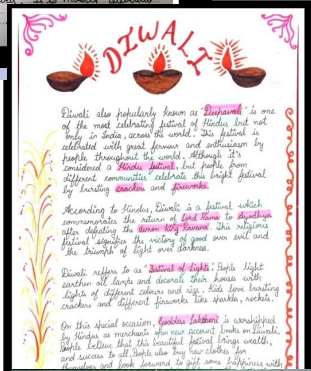
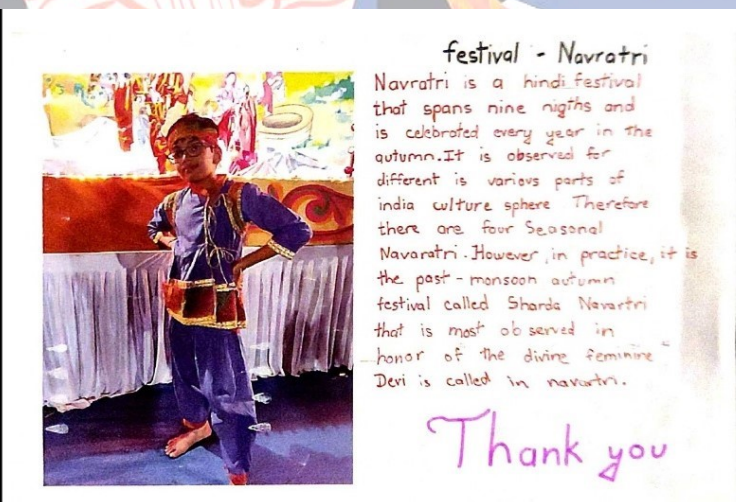
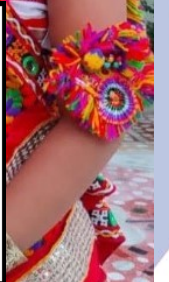
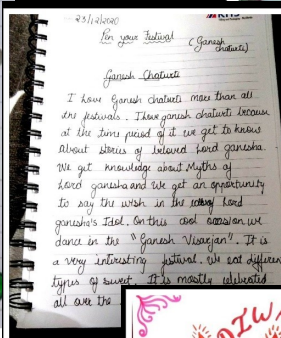
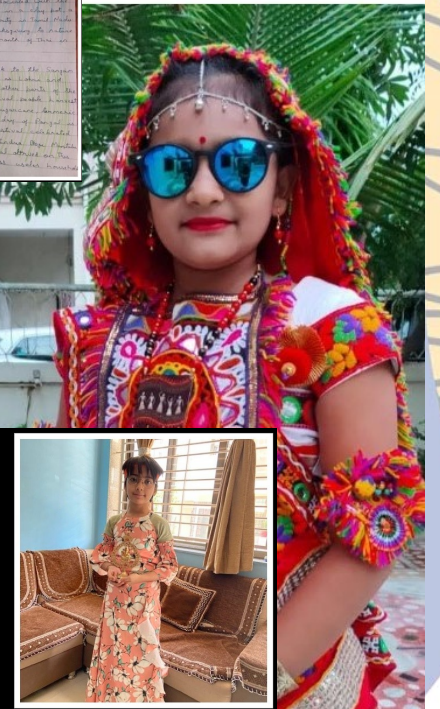
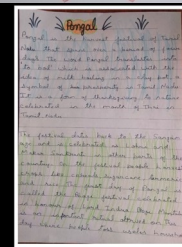
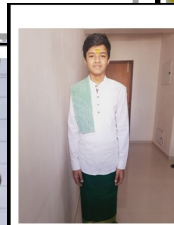
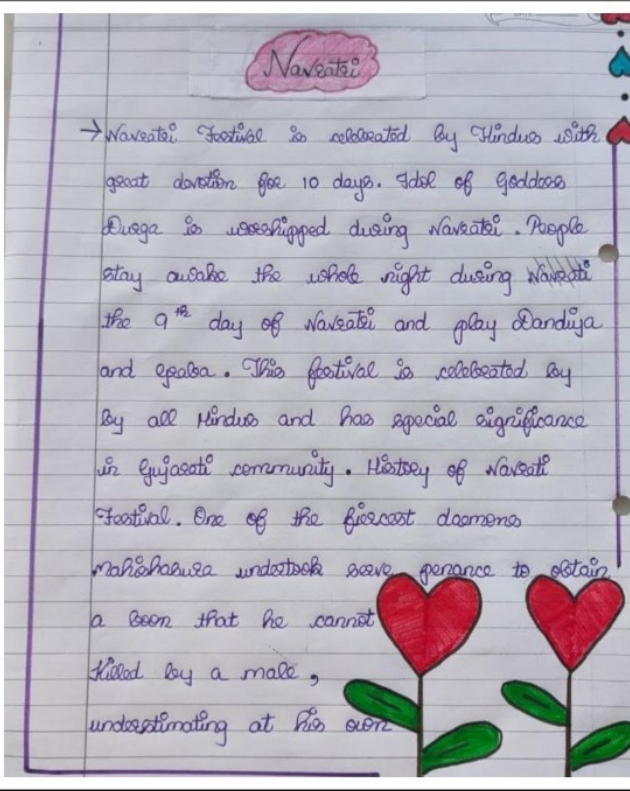
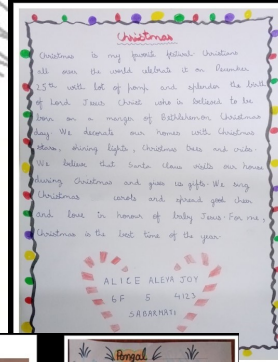
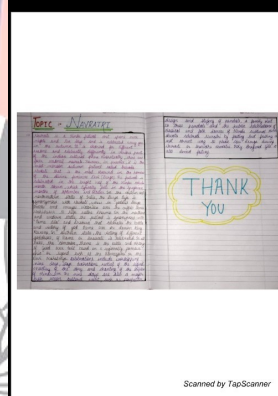

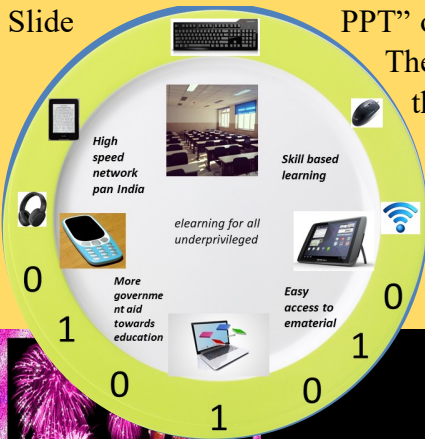


CELEBRATION OF NEW YEAR "PLATTER OF HOPE"

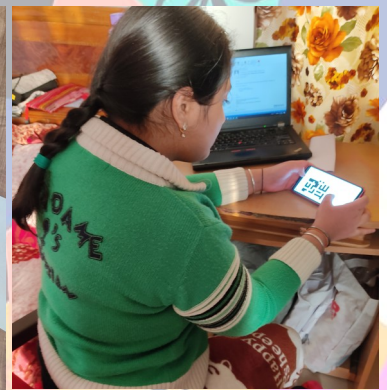

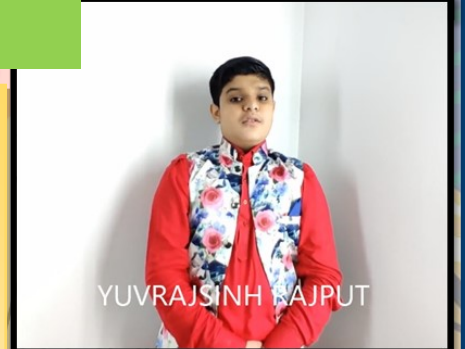
Bharat Vikas Parishad

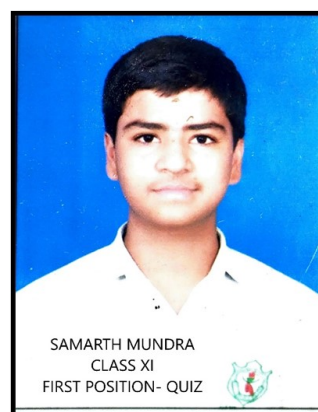


Swachhata Pakhwada- IPR
