#### CORONART CHALLENGE


The students of Classes 6 to 9 were asked to create their artwork in the form of posters, drawings, sketches etc. on the following topics:

The objective of this activity was to learn and implement safety and protection measures, through art.




















## GURU PURNIMA

Through this event the students were given a platform to express gratitude to the student-teacher relationship.















## KARGIL DIWAS



#### TRIBUTE TO KALAM
















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With the objective to maintain the importance of Hindi language and enhance its reach, Delhi Public School Gandhinagar celebrated Hindi Diwas on 14th September.



## GANDHI JAYANTI








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



#### Virtual Mock Parliament



## PLATFORM 2020 DPSJ


