"Recitation is simply the most beautiful, impressive, and widely effective mode of saying things."

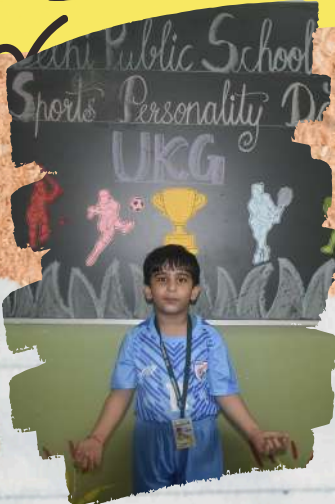

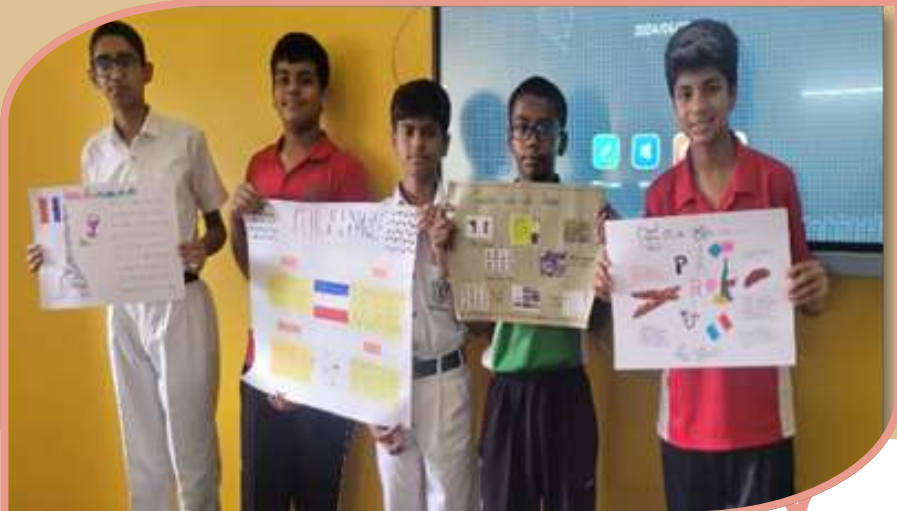
The students skilfully combined traditional Warli motifs with the vibrant hues obtained from the chemical reactions, resulting in unique and visually striking artworks.

INFOGRAPHICS- SETS & VENN DIAGRAMS

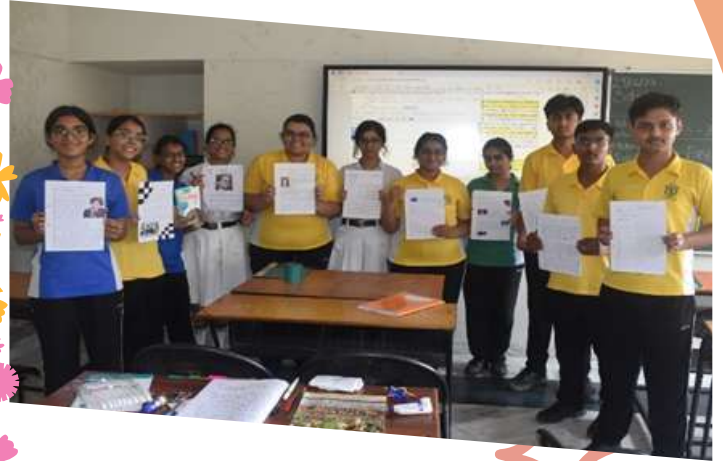

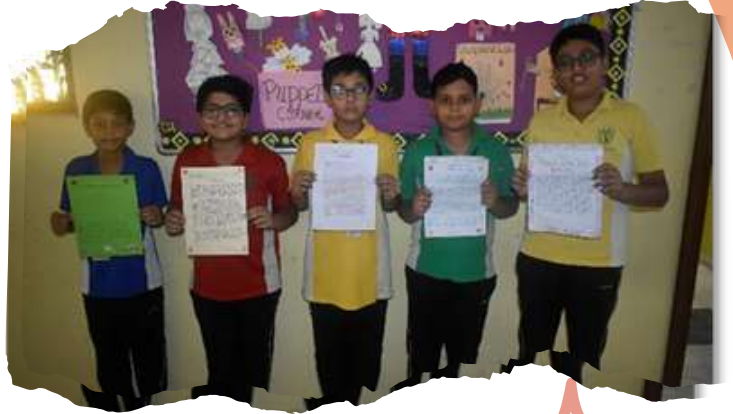
INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

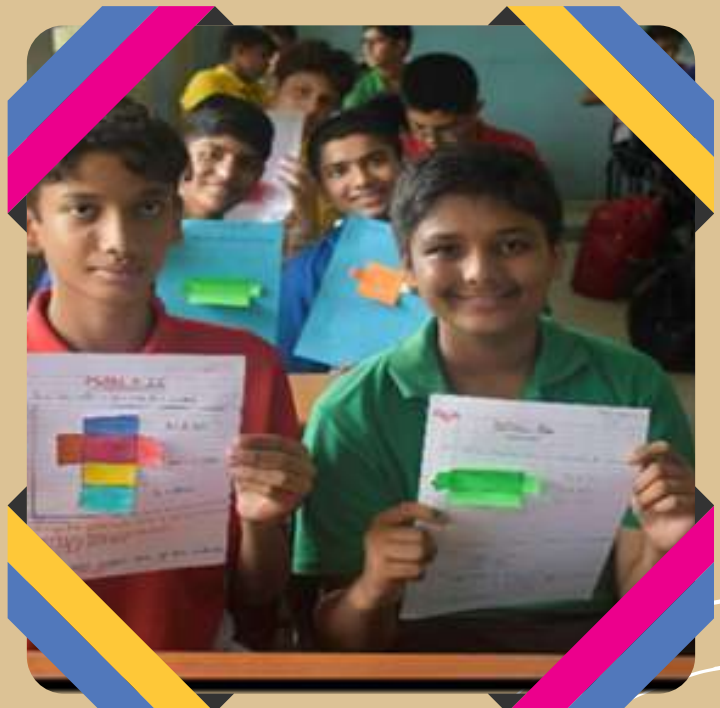

SCIENCE FAIR

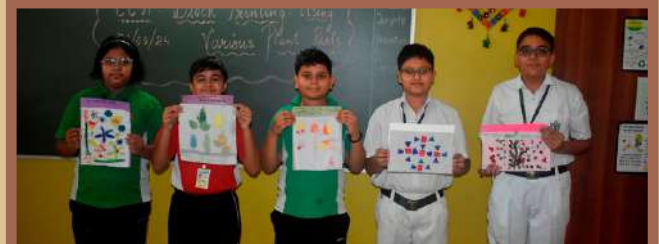

Inter House Cricket Tournament (Hard Tennis Ball)

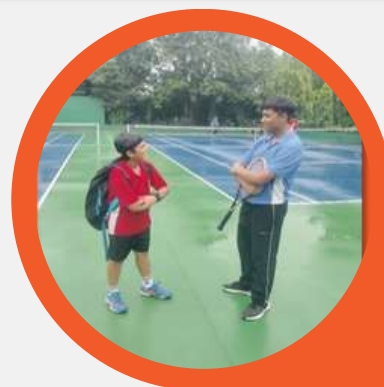
