The English Department of Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar conducted an Art Integrated Learning (AIL) activity titled *The Final Verdict* for the students of Grade XI in the month of May 2026. Based on *Train to Pakistan* by Khushwant Singh, the activity explored the complexities of human nature, moral conflict, and the realities of Partition, while strengthening students’ speaking and analytical abilities.

Inspired by Khushwant Singh’s narrative, students assumed the roles of key characters and presented their written speeches to justify their actions. Their performances reflected depth of understanding, emotional sensitivity, and confident articulation, effectively bringing forth the tensions and humanity portrayed in the novel.

The activity provided a meaningful platform for students to engage critically with the text, encouraging them to interpret, question, and express their perspectives with clarity and conviction. It enabled them to connect the themes presented by the author with real-life contexts, fostering empathy and thoughtful reflection.

Students were assessed on well-defined parameters, including character interpretation, originality of thought, strength of argument, and creativity in presentation. The activity witnessed active participation and concluded successfully, with performances that were both compelling and insightful.

Reflecting the essence of Khushwant Singh’s writing, the activity underscored that in times of conflict, it is human values and moral courage that ultimately shape one’s choices.
