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



#### Professional Development Session- Training Program on Safety for Drivers and Conductors

DPS Gandhinagar organised a 'Road Safety Training Programme' for all the members of transport department of the school. The trainers included authorities from Gujarat Government who covered several important points under this training programme. They advised the drivers not to drive school buses beyond 40 kmph, not to use their mobile phones while driving; and to halt to let other vehicles pass, wherever necessary, to avoid road accidents. The trainers suggested that the school buses must be fitted with horizontal grills, should have CCTV cameras to keep a check on all the activities going on in the bus and the drivers should have valid license with a proper badge number to drive LMV – Transport Vehicles. Availability of fire extinguisher and first aid kit in the school bus is important. They also suggested for a speed breaker outside the school on the highway road on both sides from where our school buses pass towards Koba circle and Adalaj side and advised the security guard to be present to control the traffic on the highway during dispersal. The trainers asked the drivers and conductors to follow necessary compliance while driving the school buses.
