An Inhouse workshop on “*Different Types of Preschool Curriculum*” was taken by Ms. Neeti Jain on May 14, 2025, with the objective of familiarizing educators with various approaches to early childhood education. The session was attended by all the pre-primary teachers.

The workshop covered prominent preschool curriculum including:

- **Montessori Method:** Emphasizes on self-directed activity, hands-on learning, and collaborative play.
- **Reggio Emilia Approach:** Focuses on project-based learning and the importance of the learning environment.
- **Waldorf Education:** Known for its focus on imagination, creativity, and routine-based activities.
- **HighScope Curriculum:** Encourages active participation in learning with a structured daily routine.
- **Bank Street Approach:** Stresses the value of play as a central mode of learning.

Participants were engaged in group discussions and interactive demonstrations, comparing outcomes of each curriculum type.

The workshop concluded with a Q&A session and feedback collection, with attendees appreciating the practical insights and comparative analysis provided. The workshop was highly beneficial for educators aiming to enrich their teaching practices and choose suitable curriculum tailored to the developmental needs of preschool children.
