About the Event

The Event & Participation

As part of the **Bagless Day** initiative and in alignment with the vision of **NEP 2020**, Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar organized an educational visit to **Sabarmati Gandhi Ashram, Ahmedabad** for students of Classes I to V.

The visit was conducted during school hours on **August 22, 2026**, for Classes I & II and on **August 31, 2026**, for Classes III to V.

Students explored the Ashram, visited **Hriday Kunj** and the museum, and learned about the life and values of Mahatma Gandhi. They saw original documents, photographs, letters, personal belongings, and exhibits that highlighted Gandhiji's journey. Students also learned about his interactions with eminent personalities such as **Rabindranath Tagore, Sarojini Naidu**, and many other national leaders.
