Code of Conduct:

- 1) The entry form, travel plan & students participation details, Bonafide certificate and attested identity card format which are given on the CBSE website www.cbseports.in or School website www.dps-gandhinagar.com should be filled in capital letters and send immediately on or before 18/07/2025.
- 2) Each school will send at least one staff member as Manager with the team.
- 3) Kindly do not touch the materials which are costly and sensitive like
 - (a) Smart Boards
 - (b) CCTV camera
 - (c) Window glass
 - (d) Fans, Lights, Almirahs etc.
 - (e) Projectors
- 4) Playing inside the room is strictly prohibited.
- 5) Participants are required to maintain discipline in the premises.
- 6) Switch off the lights of your room by 10:00 pm at night.
- 7) After 8:00 pm no one will be permitted to enter the premises. Nobody will be permitted to leave our school campus without Principal's permission.

- 8) Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco & smoking is strictly prohibited during the conduct of tournament and stay in the school. Anyone who violates the rule will be immediately removed from the school campus.
- 9) Any damage done to the school property during the stay by participants will have to be compensated for by the respective school.
- 10) Participants are not allowed to wear any costly ornaments or bring any valuable items. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any articles during the stay.
- 11) It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to bring the sick / injured participants to the school dispensary for the first aid / inside the tournament area.
- 12) It is compulsory for all the participants to attend the Inauguration and Valedictory Functions.
- 13) Each school must issue an identity card to every player of its school, separately for each of the discipline in which student intends to participate as per the format of CBSE.
- 14) The onus of maintaining discipline and controlling the participants/players will be purely on the coaches and managers and that is why coaches and managers are supposed to stay with their respective teams.
- 15) No players shall be permitted to participate in the CBSE Nationals without their original identity card having counter signature of the principal of the respective Cluster/Zonal level competition organizing school.
- 16) All the schools must pay Rs. 2000/- as caution money which is refundable. (For loss or damage of any Organizing School property).

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- Age criterion as specified by the rules and regulations of the CBSE Sports Committee has to be followed strictly.
- Participating schools to supply the photographs of individual team member along with the Entry Form, countersigned by concerned Principal.
- The student/player studying in IX and above to provide CBSE Registration Number.
- Protest of any nature should reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer in writing within half an hour of the declaration of the result. It should be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 1000/- (Non-refundable).
- We request you to inform us in detail regarding your arrival plans in advance so that pick-up arrangements from the Railway Station/Bus Station can be made. Reporting will be on 25/07/2025 by evening. Coach/Managers/Escorts Meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on July 25, 2025.
- **The Opening Ceremony will be held on 26/07/2025 at 8:30 a.m.**
- **All the participating teams should carry their two flags and the other necessary kit, documents etc. as per the instruction of the CBSE.**
- The March Past is compulsory for all the participating teams. They should be in their complete Sports Kit for the March Past.
- The decision of the referees will be final and binding.
- If a school, after sending its entry, wishes to withdraw from the Tournament (after the fixture has been drawn) shall, give a written request of its intention to do so at least 10 days before the commencement of the tournament to the Principal of the Organizing School.
- School withdrawing without informing or requesting the Organizing School, will be penalized with the penalty of Rs. 2000/-.
- All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player etc in original, as per the CBSE guidelines and rules should be carried personally by the Team Manager/ Coach while reporting for participation.
- The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
- Any non-designated person accompanying the team or otherwise will not be entertained to accompany the participants.
- Players must report at least **15 minutes** in advance at all reporting points.
- The host school will ensure the best possible comforts and facilities to the participants to the best of its abilities and resources. However, the participants are expected to co-operate with the host for any untoward and unexpected occurrence beyond its capabilities & control.

- You are advised to go through **CBSE Rule and Regulation 2025-26**.
- Team members are not allowed to move around the school and in the school campus and they are expected to maintain decency in their behavior & conduct.
- Use of **alcoholic drinks, tobacco & smoking** is strictly prohibited.
- **Outsiders** apart from escort teachers are not allowed to enter the school campus.
- The players will have to stay with the team and parents are not allowed to enter the school campus.

The school will not be responsible for any injury, illness or accident which may occur during an event.

- The entire schedule will be displayed before the start of the event.
- Fixtures will be drawn a day before the tournament starts.
- All participating teams shall compete in the Inter-School Tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed colour of school.

BOARDING AND LODGING

- The team Managers and Coaches are supposed to stay with their teams.
- The payment for food and accommodation will be borne by the teams and the cost of food and stay per head and per day is Rs. 500 /-. **Advance deposit of Rs. 2000/-** (refundable) for security.
- Only **vegetarian food** would be served.
- All teams are advised to carry their own mosquito repellants, lock, and key for safety.
- The team shall be responsible for their belongings and are advised not to carry **costlier items** with them.

The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the dues before their departure.

It is not **obligatory** on the part of organizing school to provide food/transport facility to school/team making **their own stay arrangements**. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/team staying outside to collect information regarding matches/fixtures/programmers.

RULES OF SPORTS & GAMES 2025-26
CBSE TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT (BOYS & GIRLS) 2025-26

1. All the matches will be played according to the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adopted by them from time to time, with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send one team comprising of a maximum of four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 years separately in the Boys & Girls" category.
3. In Boys" Category, the team shall consist of a maximum of four & minimum two players.
4. In Girls" Category, the team shall consist of a maximum of four & a minimum of two players.
5. The order of the play shall be as follows:

(iv)	A	v/s	Y
(v)	B	v/s	X

6. The matches up to quarter final stage will be played as best of the three games. Semifinal & final matches will be played as best of five games.
7. The balls to be used in the tournament shall be ITTF approved.
8. From each Cluster, the First position winning teams and First Runner Ups in each age group, separately in the Boys & Girls category, shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.
9. No change in composition of the team from Cluster level to National level will be allowed.
10. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams/Individual Players that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
11. At Cluster level the tournament will be organized on knock out basis.
12. At National level team championship shall be organized on league cum knock out basis.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP – AT CLUSTER & NATIONAL LEVELS

- (b) In addition to the team championship, separate Individual Championship will be conducted at each Cluster level.
- (c) At Cluster & National levels, the Individual Championship shall be organized on knock out basis.
- (d) In Cluster level Individual Championship, only the schools that are participating as a 'team', shall be eligible to sponsor all players to play in Individual Championship in each category separately for boys & girls.
- (e) The scoring system will be the same.
- (f) From each Cluster, top 4 players shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.

IMPORTANT

1. Players can take time out for one minute, once in whole match.
2. Expedite system shall come into operation if a game is unfinished after 10 minutes play. If

the expedite system is introduced, all subsequent games of the match shall be played under the expedite system.

3. Play shall be continuous throughout a match except that a player is entitled to:
 - (a) An interval of up to one minute between successive games of a match.
 - (b) Brief intervals for toweling after 6 points from the start of each game and at the change of ends in the last possible game of a match.
4. In each age group, as per TTFI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship" team of his/ her school. However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.
Note: For SGFI, the team will be selected on the basis of individual championship.
Top 5 players will participate in SGFI nationals.
