About the Event

Guru Nanak Jayanti, also known as *Gurpurab*, marks the birth anniversary of *Guru Nanak Dev Ji*, the first of the ten Sikh Gurus and the founder of Sikhism. He is remembered for his profound teachings on truth, equality, and compassion. To commemorate this auspicious occasion, Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar, organized a special assembly on 4 November 2025 for the primary wing. The event was filled with devotion, joy, and vibrant cultural performances, reflecting the spirit of unity and reverence.

The Event & Participation
