Title: Early intervention for bullying in pre-school	Date: 23.08.25
Venue: Audio Visual Room	Class: Pre – Primary Educators

A workshop on "Early intervention for bullying in pre-school" was conducted on August 23, 2025, at Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar by Ms. Sangeeta Joardar, to create a safe and inclusive learning environment for every child by addressing issues of bullying in the classroom. The focus was on helping teachers understand the different forms of bullying, such as verbal teasing, physical aggression, social exclusion, and feeling emotionally unsafe, along with their negative impact on a child's confidence and overall development.

The session highlighted practical strategies for teachers to identify early signs, such as withdrawal, reluctance to attend school, or sudden changes in behaviour. To provide effective solutions, emphasis was placed on building a positive classroom culture, setting clear rules of respect, and encouraging open communication so that children feel free to share their concerns. The teacher suggested interactive classroom activities to help children develop empathy, teamwork, and respect for others.

Felicitator highlighted the importance of prompt action, counseling support for both the students who is hurt and who needs behaviour guidance through regular collaboration with parents to bring about long-term behavioural changes.

The workshop reinforced that through vigilance, patience, and consistent guidance, a safe and nurturing classroom atmosphere can be ensured where every child feels valued, protected, and motivated to learn.
