DPSG MUN 2026 was successfully organized at Delhi Public School Gandhinagar on 4th and 5th August 2026, bringing together 127 registered delegates from Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar. The two-day conference provided a dynamic platform for students to engage in diplomacy, debate, leadership, and collaborative problem-solving through the simulation of the United Nations and parliamentary proceedings.

The conference featured four committees:

- United Nations General Assembly (UNGA)
- United Nations Security Council (UNSC)
- Lok Sabha
- International Press (IP)

Throughout the conference, delegates actively participated in moderated and unmoderated caucuses, policy discussions, negotiations, resolution drafting, and press coverage.
