- To improve listening and focusing skills in students.

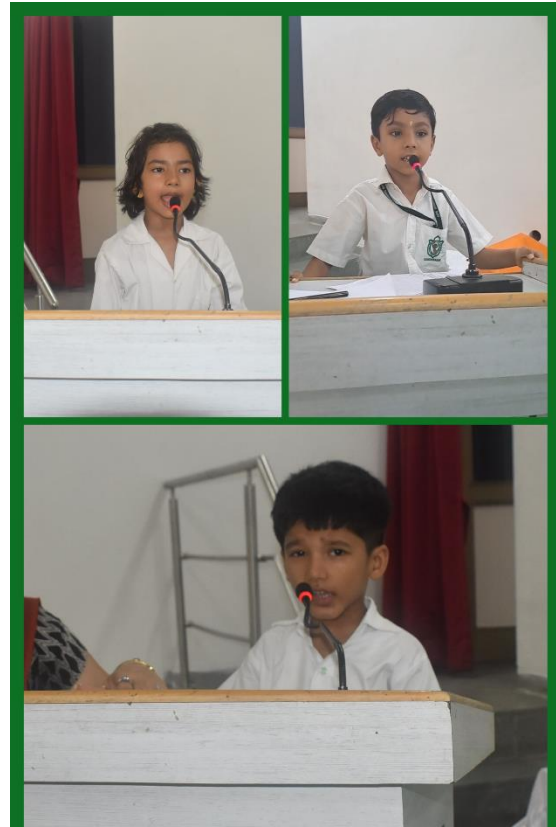
The Event and Participation:
