The results of both Class X and Class XII this year are a resounding reflection of the unwaverina commitment. perseverance, and hard work demonstrated by our students, supported by the dedicated efforts of our teachers and the constant encouragement of parents.

I am pleased to report that our school has once again achieved excellent results in both Class X and Class XII. In Class Χ, 29.48% of our students secured 90% and above. with an impressive average of 81.99%. school which is among our best performances in recent years. The academic excellence is further highlighted by top scorers such as Ekagra Maheshwari (99.40%)and Delisha Bhavin Vaid (98.80%), along with numerous subject toppers who have brought laurels to the school.

Our Class XII results too speak volumes of consistent academic rigor, with an overall school average of 80.52%. streams, Across **Humanities** recorded an average of 84.45%, Commerce 79.90%, and Science 79.76%. 14.84% of our students achieved 90% and above,

with Humanities student Mahi Doshi leading with a stellar 95.6%. and commendable performances from students Wadhwani like Hemansh (Commerce - 95%) and Prince Pilakhwal (Science - 93.6%). These results are not just numbers, but a testament to the academic ethos of DPS Gandhinagar, which nurtures curiosity, discipline, and a love for learning. It is a moment of great satisfaction to see our school's 21-year journey marked with continual progress and excellence.






Concise Biography Illustration - Hindi Litterateur

The event was a resounding success and aligned perfectly with the school's vision of promoting experiential learning.






### Character Speech Writing









Cloud Shape Chart Making on Sanskrit Subhashit
