Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar, aims to give students a window to the wider world. The school ensures that the students develop the skills that a sound education provides and the competence essential for success and leadership. This year the students of DPS Gandhinagar showcased exemplary performance in Secondary School Examination (SSE) and Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSCE). In Class 10, 287 students took their board exams, out of which, 80 secured above 90% aggregate marks. In Class 12, 121 students appeared for their board exams and 16 students secured above 90% aggregate marks.

#### **How Far? How High?**


