1. Important Dates :

- Coach / Manager's Meeting : 30th November (Time – 7:30 pm)

4. Registration and Exit :

Participants who have registered will play this tournament, on arrival registration will not be entertained. Kindly contact Mr. Sandeep (**8866438821**) for **Registration and Exit only**.

5. Boarding and Lodging :

- DPS, Gandhinagar will provide accommodation to all outside participants in the school campus. The team managers and coaches of outside participants are required to stay with their participants.
- Free pick up and drop facility shall be provided to all outside participants from Railway Station or Bus stand on request.
- The participants shall be required to pay boarding and lodging charges @ 350/- and Rs. 50 extra for blanket (per day) per head at the time of reporting.
- For additional days stay, extra amount will be charged against meals, as per CBSE norms.

- The participants are required to deposit an amount of Rs. 2000/- as caution money which shall be refunded at the time of dispersal of the participants.
- The participants shall be provided with bedding (Mattresses, bed sheets and pillows). However, participants must pay Rs. 50/- extra for blanket per day.
- All participants are expected to carry their own lock, key and mosquito repellents.
- The team shall be responsible for their belongings. Participants are advised not to carry expensive gadgets as the host school shall not be held responsible for any loss.
- The team managers are required to settle the account and obtain NOC from the designated authority before their departure.

6. General Discipline :

- ✓ The team managers are required to settle the account and obtain NOC from the designated authority before their departure.
- ✓ It is expected from each team to be in absolute discipline during the tournament and stay in DPS, Gandhinagar campus. If any kind of indiscipline is noticed the team may be debarred to play further.
- ✓ The school campus is under surveillance of CCTV cameras. Therefore, keep your participants informed about the same.
- ✓ Last entry in the school campus is permitted up to 9:00 pm only.
- ✓ If the participants indulge themselves into any kind of damage to the school property they need to pay for it before they leave for the station.
- ✓ Consumption of Alcohol, Smoking, Chewing of tobacco or its products is strictly prohibited in DPS Campus.
- ✓ Please switch off the light & turn off water taps when not in use.
- ✓ Misuse of school property scribbling on walls, furniture, bulletin boards, toilet walls (Loo) etc. will be severely dealt with. Breakages of any kind are subject to a fine or payment for replacement repairs.
- ✓ Participants are advised not to invite any unauthorised person(s) including relatives/friends) from outside as they shall not get permission to visit or stay in the campus.
- ✓ The participants leaving station before scheduled departure are required to inform DPS authorities at least 4 hours before their departure.
- ✓ After the event, the dispersal of the bus to railway station will be done only after all the seats are occupied (will not be done for individual participants).
- ✓ Local participants need to inform the authorities in advance if they need food from school on payable basis.
- ✓ The tournament shall be conducted as per the rules framed / followed by CBSE Sports 2021-22. A copy of same can be downloaded from CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in.
- ✓ All participating schools are requested to bring school flag.
- ✓ It is mandatory for all participants to be in their sportswear / school uniform during opening / closing ceremony.
- ✓ The participants must report to the venue at least 20 minutes in advance for the event.
- ✓ The decision of referees shall remain final and binding upon all concerned.

- ✓ No team shall be entertained if all desired documents are not submitted at the time of reporting.
- ✓ DPS Gandhinagar and its management shall not be responsible for any injury or illness during tournament or stay of participants in its campus. However, best possible medical aid and assistance shall be arranged / provided on demand.
- ✓ Use of vulgar and objectionable language, display of violence behaviour etc will not be allowed.
- ✓ The school will take utmost care of all participants, coach and managers who stay in campus, however in cases of any mishap the school shall not bear the responsibility.
- ✓ All rules and regulations are for smooth running and smooth functioning of the tournament. The school authority reserves the right to change and add the rules accordingly. All are requested to abide by the rules.
