1 Cut four rectangular pieces from a cardboard. The dimensions of each piece should be 4 inches by 8 inches.




2 Wrap the rectangular pieces with craft papers. Stick the papers properly to the cardboard so that they don't come out.




3 Using a dark coloured sketch pen, write "Thank you!", "Please", "Excuse me!", and "Sorry" on the cardboards.

Famous monuments of India



Monuments are very reliable sources of information. They explain various events and developments that took place in the past. They also present the beautiful art of that period. Let us have a look at some of the famous monuments in India.


1 The **Gol Gumbaz** in Bijapur, Karnataka, boasts one of the largest unsupported domes in the world. It is the mausoleum of Sultan Mohammed Adil Shah.



2 The **Palace of Mysore** in Karnataka has beautifully designed square towers at cardinal points, covered with domes. Also known as Amba Vilas Palace, it was the residence of the Wodeyar Maharajas of the Mysore state. The palace complex consists of the Residential Museum, temples, and shrines.
