## City schools score 100% success

### 130 DPS-Bopal Students Get 90% And Above; 37 At St Kabir

**Ahmedabad:** The long-awaited Class 12 result was finally announced on Friday by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

The girls once again outperformed the boys by 3.29%. Over 33,000 students scored above 95% while 1.34 lakh students scored above 90% this year in the country. The students were all smiles in the city as they checked their results. Most of the schools in the city registered cent per cent results. The students even managed to score full marks in various subjects.

Once again, the students of DPS-Bopal performed stupendously and stood up to the expectations of all. Of the total 388 students who had appeared for the exams in various streams, 130 secured 90% and above marks. By scoring 98.2%, Prachi Jindal emerged as the top-

per in the Science stream. She was followed by Sangini Gandhi with 97.8%. As many as 33 students secured cent per cent marks in various subjects. At DPS, Gandhinagar, 53 students appeared in the exam, of which seven secured above 90%. With 98.6%, Sakshi Rao emerged as the school topper.

She was followed by Shaneshil Borah with 94.8%. Of the 69 students who took the exam in Science stream at Maharaja Agrasen Vidyalaya, most

of the students secured distinction. Keshini Trivedi topped the school's merit list in Science by scoring 96.40% and Prashant Srivastav cornered second position with 94.20%.

Of the 83 students who took the exam at St Kabir School, 37 scored 90% and above. Manush Patel with 96.2% emerged as the school topper.
