Sorting the grains helps to develop a child's fine motor skills, teaches them differentiation of colours and shapes, boosts eye-hand coordination, pincer grip, and also gives them recognition of different grains. To add, it is also used as a tool to increase the child's concentration. Keeping this in mind, Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar organized a "Sorting the Grains Event" for the Nursery students on July 5, 2024.

During the event, Children were given a bowl of mixed grains like kidney beans (Rajma), chickpeas (Chhole), and dried peas. All are different in shape, color, and size.
