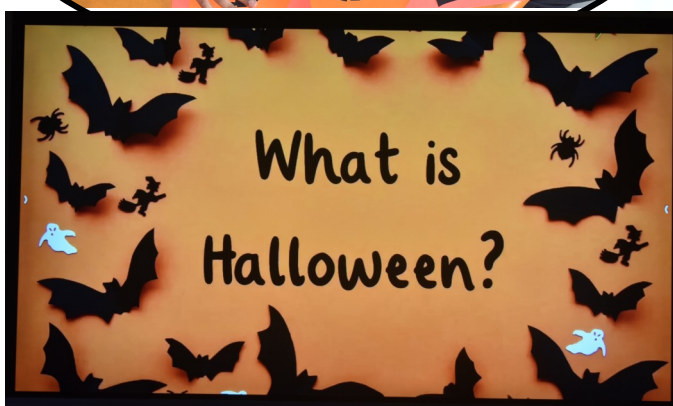




## Halloween Day

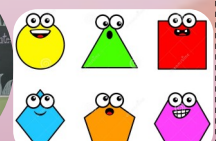
## Little Picasso Event

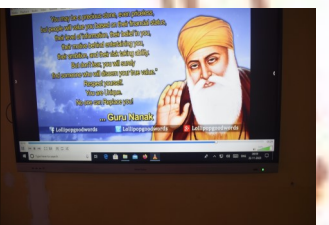
## Visit to Traffic Park

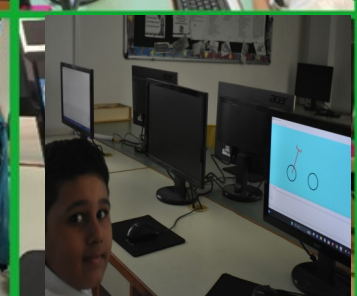
## Mere Desh Ke Dharati - Inter House Singing Competition

## Ekalavya Model Residential School Recruitment Test - 2023



EMRS started in the year 1997-98 to impart quality education to children in remote areas and enable them to avail opportunities in high and professional educational courses.

As a part of the development program of EMRS model and the conduction of examination for key posts, DPS

Gandhinagar was selected as the nodal centre for Gandhinagar District. Ms. Anju Singh, Principal, was appointed as the City Coordinator with about 15 schools as exam centres.

The schools of Gandhinagar district that were chosen as exam centres included- Divine Child International School, Puna International School, Podar International School, Kendriya Vidyalaya (2 branches), Shree Swaminarayan International School, Pinnacle Public School, Hillwoods School, Anand Niketan (2 branches), Bright International School, Om Landmark School, BAPS Vidyamandir, Samarpan Public School, Mahapragya Vidya Niketan and Delhi Public School Gandhinagar

The examinations were conducted over a period of 4 days and two shifts, viz. 16-17 December and 23-24 December. These exams were for the posts of- Principals, PGTs, Hostel Wardens, Jr. Secretariat Assistants, Lab Assistants, TGTs and Accountants.

In Gandhinagar more than 15,000 candidates were registered per shift and during the course of these exams more than 35,000 candidates appeared at the appointed centres. DPS Gandhinagar alone saw a footfall of 200 candidates over the 4 days in both morning and evening shifts.
